Mr. McCarty graduated from Mississippi State University, and spent 35 years in business, including executive positions with Ralston Purina, BP, Central Soya and Consolidated Nutrition. He was a member of the board of directors of Agribrands International, a NYSE company.

Mr. McCarty has served on the boards of several not for profit corporations over the years.

At Riverview School in East Sandwich, MA, he served as Chairman of the Board of Directors for 3 years, and as a board member for 12 years. Riverview is a private school with an international reputation for serving learning disabled children through high school and as young adults through about age 22, with a transition program called GROW.

Mr. McCarty was a board member of The Horizon School, Birmingham, and served as an officer immediately following its separation from UAB, during the time that the school was organizing itself as a separate corporation.

He was a found member and Chairman of the Board for Ability Housing of Northeast Florida, a not for profit organization that provides independent housing for learning disabled individuals in the Jacksonville, FL area.
